- 01

A 48-hour developer-experience stress test. Over a hundred engineers pick up your board, SDK, or API cold — your documentation and nothing else, under deadline. Every place onboarding breaks surfaces in one weekend, and we write it up and send it to you.
- 02

Your product inside real projects. A named award means teams build to your product, not around it — Bambu Lab’s “Best Use of 3D Printing” and Lovable’s “Best Use of Vibe Coding” are running examples. You leave with working demos and footage you can reuse.
- 03

US developer validation. If you are entering or expanding in the US market: American engineers built real projects on your platform in 48 hours, publicly, with names, video, and write-ups attached.
- 04

A recruiting look no resume gives you. You watch candidates debug hardware under deadline, in a team, before you schedule an interview. Gold partners also sit on the judging panel.
- 05

Reach that outlasts the weekend. Projects, teams, and partner logos carry through our LinkedIn, Luma, and Discord — and participants post their own builds.
